- Last line: Would you if you were me.

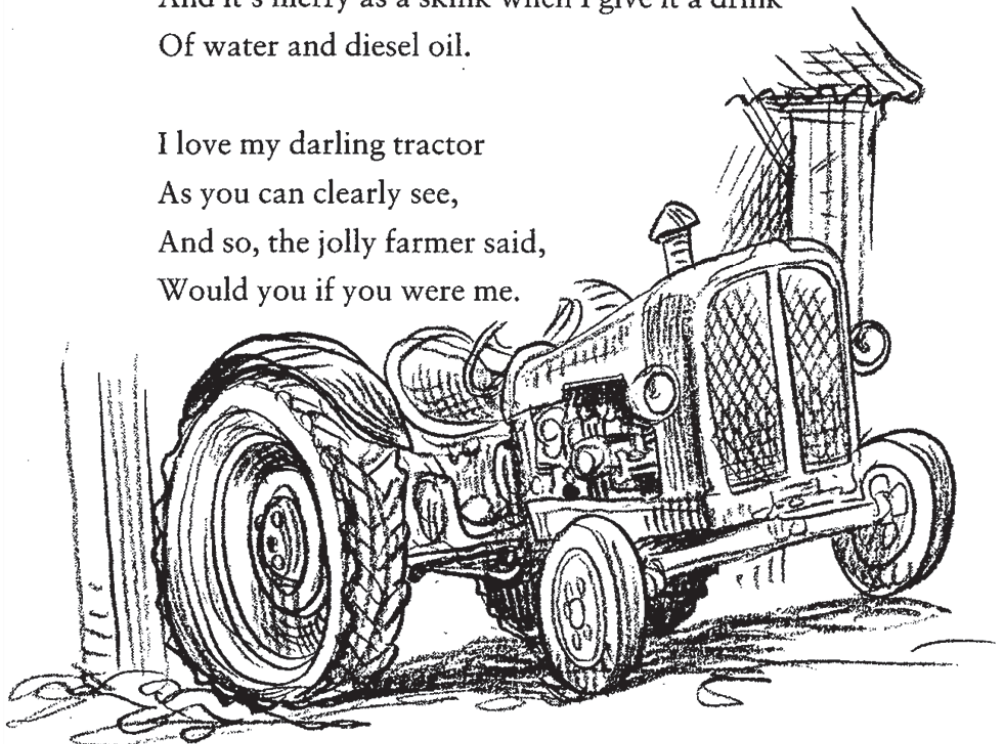
I Love My Darling Tractor
